7.00pm	HONKSKI ORO WORKSHOP with Dva (pronounced D-vah). Dva is simply the Macedonian word for "two" which expresses the great love of playing together as a duo shared by its two members: Tunji Beier and Linsey Pollak. They create improvisations and compositions that draw on the traditions of Macedonia and South India, their greatest musical influences. The world premiere of HONKSKI ORO is funded by a Wollongong City Council Large Cultural Grant
