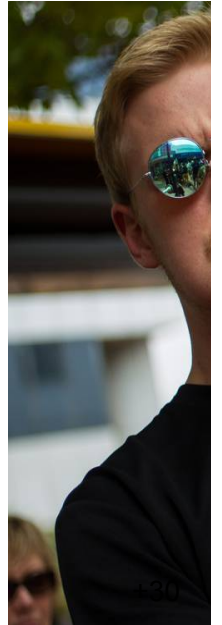


# Honk! Oz festival parades through Wollongong: photos
